Level 1: Jesus is God's Son

Focus: God's Son is "Born on earth as a Little Child"

Children will become familiar with the stories of the coming of God's Son to us on earth, as He is born of Mary as a "little child." They will be introduced to the concept of "waiting" and "listening" for something good, and preparing to "meet the Lord." The birth of Christ is set within the context of human family and God's family.

 Give examples of things you had to wait to happen (or receive). Describe how you felt and whether or not the waiting was difficult, or worthwhile. Compare waiting for special events in your life to the Church waiting for the birth of Jesus during the Nativity Fast. Anticipate the coming of Jesus Christ as a very important event. Identify the people and things that are featured in the icon of the Nativity of Our Lord. 	 Explain how silence is important for being able to listen. Tell how Mary listened for and responded to God's call. Listen, in the hymns of the services, for examples of preparation for the coming of Christ. Demonstrate an understanding of the icon of the feast of the Presentation. Draw a picture of an event in Mary's life.

 Define saints as special people (friends) of God. Tell the story of St. Romanos the "sweet-singer." Find the image of St. Romanos in the icon, and the singers with him.
