<u>Highlights</u>

By the end of this study unit, participants will be able to:

- *Identify* the Nativity Fast as the period of preparation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ.
- **Compare** the Great Lenten Fast with the Nativity Fast, **giving examples** of what is the same and what is different.
- **Describe** the importance and **give examples** of waiting for something good, and reflect on its positive (or negative) effects in our lives.
- **Explain** how the feast of the Entrance of the Theotokos is significant in our preparation for the Nativity of Christ.
- **Demonstrate** an understanding of sainthood and how the saints commemorated in this time period provide examples for us.
- **Discuss** and **reflect** upon the life and works of St. Nicholas.
- **Relate** how the Church remembers the prophets, kings and all the faithful people of the Old Testament who served as God's witnesses.
- **Recognize** those who prepared the way for the coming of the Savior and gave us the Theotokos who agreed to give birth to God's Son in the Flesh.
- *Identify* Jesus Christ as the "Sun of Righteousness" who fulfills the Law and the Prophets.
